

Education minister says sorry in parliament

Education minister ANM Ehsanul Hoque Milon on Tuesday indicated that the ongoing Higher Secondary Certificate and equivalent examinations on three subjects would be retaken.

Milon also said in the Jatiya Sangsad on Tuesday afternoon that he was sorry if his comments had hurt anyone.

Replying to a supplementary question, he also said that errors had been found in questions numbering 6 and 7 of physics 1st paper and candidates

would receive full marks for those questions.

The minister was responding to a question from Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami lawmaker Shafiqul Islam Masud about government measures to address students' grievances during the question-answer session chaired by Deputy Speaker Kayser Kamal.

On Monday, HSC examinations were held on physics 1st paper, accounting 1st paper, and logic 1st paper while numerous students faced difficulties to attend the examinations due to incessant rains at many places across the country.

Milan said that it was raining during the examinations on Monday and they had got complaints that many got wet and could not take the exam properly.

Mentioning that they had already stopped the examinations in Chattogram division, he continued that they will have to retake them.

'In this case, we have thought carefully that when we go to take the Chattogram division examinations on physics 1st paper, accounting 1st paper, and logic 1st paper with another set of question papers - at that time we will be able to arrange to retake these examinations,' he said.

Meanwhile, the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Sylhet on Tuesday issued show-cause notices to four teachers for errors in the physics 1st paper questions numbering 6 and 7 of the ongoing HSC examinations.

The notices were served on Md Mujibur Rahman, professor of physics at Sreemangal Government College, Kazi Junaid Al Amin, assistant professor of physics at Brindaban Government College, Habiganj, Moshaddeq Hossain

Khan, assistant professor of physics at Murari Chand College, Sylhet, and Mohammad Helal Uddin, lecturer of physics at Sylhet Government Model School and College who reviewed the question paper.

The teachers were asked to inform in writing within three working days as to why departmental action would not be taken against them due to such serious errors in the question paper.
