

Rest of HSC exams under Ctg board suspended

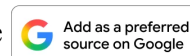

The Chattogram education board has suspended all remaining Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations until further notice due to the flood situation.

A revised examination schedule will be announced later, according to a notice issued by the board's Controller of Examinations Md Parvez Sazzad Chowdhury last night.

The notice said the decision was taken in line with a resolution of the Inter-Education Board Coordination Committee after considering the overall situation in the flood-affected areas, examinees' physical and mental wellbeing, consultations with stakeholders, and travel difficulties caused by flood-damaged roads.

HSC exams to continue nationwide, except under Chattogram Board

Earlier, the board had postponed exams scheduled to be held by July 16 because of flooding triggered by heavy rain in the Chattogram region.

The latest suspension came amid ongoing protests by HSC examinees.

Over the past two days, a group of students demonstrated in front of the Chattogram education board, demanding the resignation of Education Minister ANM Ehsanul Hoque Milon.

Nearly 1 lakh students from 283 colleges across Chattogram, Cox's Bazar, Rangamati, Khagrachhari, and Bandarban are sitting for the HSC exams under the board this year.
