

4,384 primary teacher recruits to join on Oct 1

Selected candidates to report to district primary education offices before receiving postings and training

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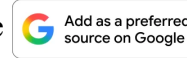

Nearly eight months after the final results were published, 14,384 candidates selected for assistant teacher posts at government primary schools are set to join on October 1, the Ministry of Primary and Mass Education said today.

The selected candidates will report to the district primary education offices in their respective districts, according to a ministry notice signed by Deputy Secretary Rajib Kumar Sarkar.

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The ministry said appointment letters will be issued in due course. The recruits will receive their postings after joining and undergo training later.

The final results of the 2025 Primary Assistant Teacher Recruitment were published on February 8, recommending 14,384 candidates for appointment.

A nationwide written examination was held on January 9 in 61 districts, excluding the three hill districts. A total of 69,265 candidates qualified for the viva voce.

After the results were published, selected candidates staged demonstrations at Shahbagh and outside the Directorate of Primary Education (DPE) headquarters in Mirpur, demanding appointment letters and posting orders.

On April 27, police allegedly baton-charged several candidates while dispersing a sit-in outside the DPE headquarters.

Later, on May 10, the Directorate of Primary Education instructed district primary education officers to conduct police verification of the selected candidates, including checks on their previous activities and the authenticity of their documents, in line with a ministry directive issued on May 3.
