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Govt dissolves ad hoc committees of non-govt madrasahs

The government on Sunday dissolved the ad hoc committees of all non-government Dakhil and Alim-level madrassahs and directed the institutions to form new committees within 15 working days.

The Bangladesh Madrassah Education Board issued a notice on its web site announcing the decision.

Dakhil and Alim are equivalent to the secondary school certificate and higher secondary certificate levels respectively.

According to the notice, issued under Regulation 64 of the Bangladesh Madrassah Education Board (managing committee and governing body of non-government madrassahs at Dakhil and Alim levels) Regulations, 2025, all ad hoc committees, including those whose terms had already expired, have been dissolved.

The board instructed madrassahs to obtain the necessary approval and form new ad hoc committees within the next 15 working days.

The notice also outlined changes to the committee formation process under the amended 2025 regulations.

Under the revised sub-regulation (3) of clause (h) of Regulation 64, the head of a madrassah must submit, through the upazila executive officer and district commissioner, a list of three proposed candidates for the post of president from among education enthusiasts, noted social workers, public representatives, or serving or retired government officials of grade 9 or above, along with nominations for other committee members, to the relevant education board.

For madrassahs located within city corporation areas, the institution head must send the proposal to the education board concerned through the divisional commissioner.

The notice was signed by board registrar professor SM Touhiduzzaman.

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
