

July 11 HSC, equivalent exams postponed under Chattogram Board

Bangladesh Inter-Education Board Coordination Committee says the decision was taken due to ongoing floods

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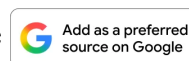

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) and equivalent examinations scheduled for tomorrow (July 11, 2026) in all districts under the Chattogram Board have been postponed in view of the ongoing flood situation.

The Bangladesh Inter-Education Board Coordination Committee announced the decision in a notice today, signed by Prof Syed Akhtaruzzaman, chairman of the committee.

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The postponement applies to HSC, Alim, HSC (BMT), HSC (Vocational), and Diploma in Commerce examinations scheduled for July 11 in the districts under Chattogram board.

However, exams under other education boards will be held as scheduled.

The revised schedule for the postponed examinations will be announced later, the committee said.
