

Govt postpones Wednesday's HSC, equivalent exams in Ctg division

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The government on early Wednesday postponed the ongoing Higher Secondary Certificate and equivalent examinations in all districts under the Chattogram division scheduled for the day (Wednesday) due to adverse weather conditions.

The Bangladesh Inter-Education Board Coordination Committee issued a press release regarding the matter on early Wednesday.



According to the press release, in view of the current flood situation, the HSC, Alim, HSC (BMT), HSC (Vocational), and Diploma in Commerce examinations scheduled for Wednesday have been postponed in all districts under the Chattogram division and under the jurisdiction of the Chittagong Education Board.

Examinations on the specified date across other education boards will proceed as usual, the release continued.

The schedule for the postponed examinations would be announced later, the release added.

Earlier on Tuesday night the education ministry at first postponed the examinations in Chattogram and Rangamati districts.

Later, the ministry also postponed the examinations in Cox's Bazar district.

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
