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Pvt polytechnic entrepreneurs call for unity to reform technical edn

Private polytechnic entrepreneurs from across the country have urged for unity to modernise technical education and build an industry-ready workforce aligned with global standards.

The call was made during a discussion titled United Entrepreneurs, Quality Technical Education and a Skilled Bangladesh at Daffodil Plaza of Dhanmondi in Dhaka on Sunday, said a press release.



Moderated by CCN Polytechnic Institute chairman Md Tariquul Islam Chowdhury, the event featured Daffodil Group chairman Md Sabur Khan as chief guest.

Speakers highlighted the critical role of diploma engineers in the country's industrialisation and called for eliminating differences among entrepreneurs to address the ongoing enrolment crisis.

They emphasised replacing the current exam-based system with practical, lab-based and industry-integrated education.
