

NU to undertake reforms to restore quality education: VC

Speaking as chief guest at an exchange of views with teachers at Shahid Zia Degree College at Gabtali in Bogura on Thursday, Professor Amanullah

emphasised that the university is working relentlessly to dismantle the prolonged academic deadlock and ensure administrative transparency, said a press release.

Reflecting on the historical significance of the region, the vice-chancellor stressed that presenting these unfiltered historical truths to the new generation remains a key responsibility.

Professor Amanullah outlined initiatives focused on teacher training, research integration and technology-driven learning.

He asserted that the National University is shifting beyond a mere examining body to become a modernised platform for higher education—updating curricula and expanding digital learning to foster global competitiveness.

The event concluded with the vice-chancellor participating in a tree-planting initiative as part of the university's 'green campus' campaign.
